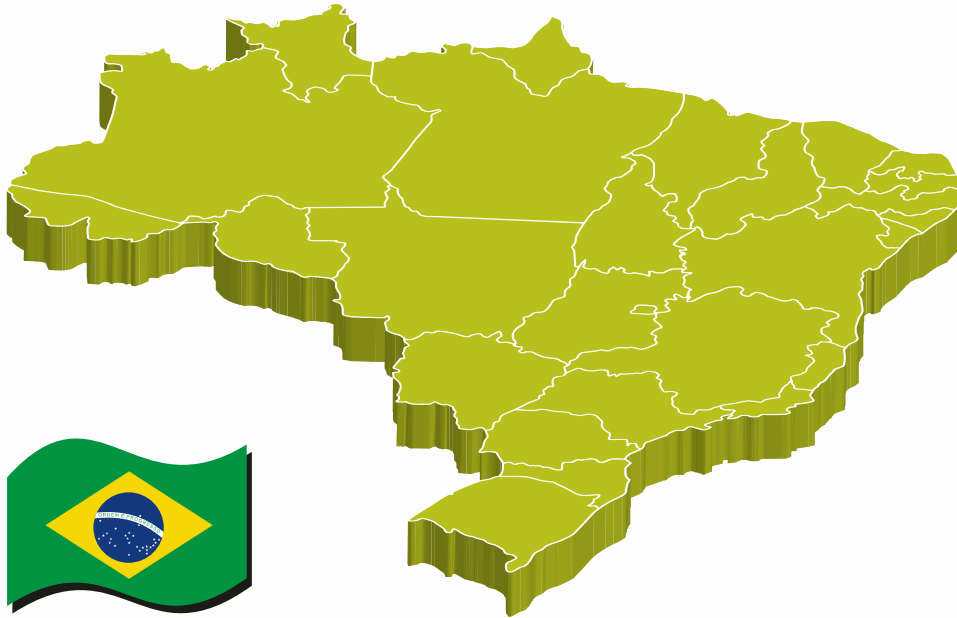

Sports of Brazil



Football (soccer) is the most popular sport in Brazil with the national team consistently among the best in the world, winning the World Cup a record 5 times.

Martial Arts Capoeira is one of the most popular forms of martial arts in Brazil.



Footvolley Invented in the 1960's, footvolley is a combination of football and volleyball.

Tennis Brazil is represented in major tennis tournaments, such as Wimbledon and the US Open and is home to some of the best players in the world.

Basketball The national basketball team of Brazil and its players are well respected in this sport on an international level.

Motorsport As a nation, Brazil has won more than 100 Formula One races, testifying to the calibre of sportsmen that emanate from this nation in the motorsports arena.

Volleyball As the second most popular sport in Brazil, both the male and female national volleyball teams participate at Olympic level.

Rugby Rugby is a much-loved sport in Brazil, but its teams have not yet reached the level at which they qualify for major competitions (such as World Cups).

Brazilwood

Brazil wood is a type of tree native to Brazil. They produce a yellow and red flower.

Brazilwood trees were harvested for a red dye and was eventually shipped to Europe. Fun Fact Brazil is named after the brazilwood tree



The White Ipe trees are huge trees that can grow up to 150 feet. Before the Ipe tree blooms it drops all of its leaves and produces amazing clusters of white flowers.

Mangabeiras are a small trees that grow to be 10 to 25 feet tall. The Mangabeira grows in sandy soil. The mangabeiras produce an orange-yellow fruit called mangabas. You can actually eat the fruit!
