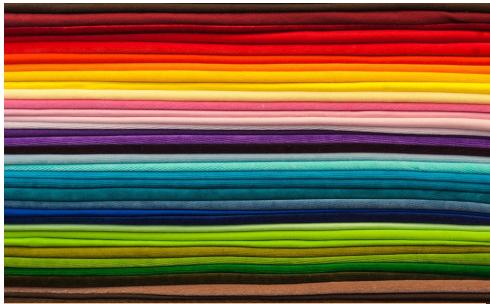
Men often wear solid color shirts, sometimes with a pattern

Adowa: the antelope dance, it imitates jumping of an antelope

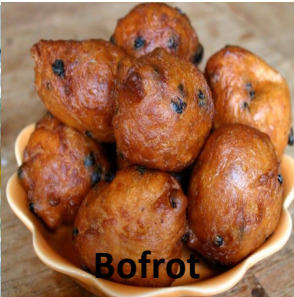


Kpanlogo: Recreational song, someone tells a story and the group makes up a song and dance about it
