**Topic:** “Right to Self-Determination”

Aware of the amount of poverty in de-colonized countries,

Convinced that since the overruling power retreated out of the area, that the decolonized country no longer has the care from the overruling power,

Observing that the UN has existed for 69 years, and in that time, millions of people have gained self-determination. However, there are still many people without this right,

Keeping in mind that the right to self-determination is a people's ability to freely determine their political status and freely pursue their economic, social and cultural development,

Noting with regret that in the Middle East, self-determination is poor in women and children,

1. Calls upon the UN for help with peacekeeping in decolonized countries because these countries are prone to fighting over territory and supplies;
2. Further requests that the UN members keep track of these countries' growth;
3. Draws the attention to the Russia / Ukraine crisis and notes that a possible solution would be for the Crimean people attached to Russia to follow the traditional

country transfer protocol, then move to Russia so Russia would no longer feel an attachment to Crimea and potentially retreat;

4. Notes that decolonized countries are fighting amongst themselves. Some people have nowhere to live due to this senseless violence;

5. Recommends that all adults get a good education on how to make a living and that the UN could give funding for buildings in decolonized countries where the citizens that have nowhere to go to stay, and also recommends that the people be paid to help build the shelters so that they would be paid along with teaching the people about jobs;

6. Requests that labor-intensive work programs be put in place such as the construction of shelters or road construction for impoverished peoples in decolonized countries;

7. Calls on wealthy countries to donate money to be used for shelters for minority groups rather than them fighting uselessly over shelter;

8. Further invites a UN Representative to be a representative of a minority group to the governing group for the minority group's voice to be heard.
