Topic: “Food Security”

The FAO, reminding all nations of the growing problem of food security, and its past actions of providing healthy and nutritious food to refugee camps;

Affirming that knowledge on how to farm and maintain food security is important for developed and developing nations;

Aware of the clear disconnect in supply and demand of the agricultural industries;

Recognizing the connection between agricultural and food issues and global climate change;

Affirming that much work is needed to end food insecurity;

1. Calls for extensive research to understand the growth rates and metrics for world hunger and food security,
2. Calls for research to understand the development and assess the effectiveness of world hunger aid programs and non-governmental aid programs,
3. Encourages the financial support of nation stricken by brutality and poverty,
4. Challenges nations with the question: “why can’t everyone get food?,”
5. Proposes the formation of a committee to regulate what is grown to maintain the growth of nutrient rich foods,
6. Supports Echo Asia and similar organizations that provide farmers with seeds for

planting crops,

7. Endorses fair trade organizations that make sure farmers are not exploited,
8. Supports the practice of individual farmers farming a variety of crops,
9. Supports finding ways to grow crops in the cities through in-city gardens,
10. Supports the practicing local farming and trading and encourages the reduction in prevalence of international food markets,
11. Supports the research of resource efficient farming technology,
