Topic: "Human Rights on the Internet"

The General Assembly, reminding all nations of the celebration of the 50th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which recognizes the inherent dignity, equality and inalienable rights of all global citizens,

Realizing the need of establishing an international optional NGO,

Declaring that it acts independently,

Bearing in mind that the NGO will monitor the cyber monitoring activities of the world governments,

Further supports mass education on the internet,

1. Expresses its hope that all countries will participate actively;
2. Emphasizing that everyone should have rights on the internet;
3. Keeping in mind the internet bill of rights as the security standards which must be met by all countries;
4. Draws the attention for the need of education on the internet;
5. Taking into account the safety of citizens on the internet on the basis of the content which is accepted by all;
6. Further takes into account the challenges ahead of this NGO; and
7. Strongly recommends free internet access for people who cannot afford it.
