



**United Nations Security Council**

**Topic:** Situation in Ukraine

**Co-Sponsors:** France, Rwanda, Australia, Chad, Azerbaijan, Argentina, Republic of Korea, Chile, United Kingdom, United States of America, Russia, China

The Security Council, alarmed by the rising number of dead and displaced citizens, Emphasizing the importance of the withdrawal of all foreign military forces in Ukraine and ensuring no harm is implemented on the national security of Ukraine,

Believing that accessible humanitarian aid must be sent into the target areas of Ukraine,

Guided by the Minsk Agreement that primarily orders an immediate ceasefire in Donetsk and Luhansk, withdrawal of heavy weapons by both sides, and disarmament of all illegal groups,

1. Encourages that medical aid and basic resources are delivered to people who were forced to leave their homes and are now living in deplorable conditions;
2. Requests that a peace summit be taken into consideration by all sides of the conflict;
3. Recommends that Crimea determine its own future through a fair public vote mediated by United Nations officials with certain limits to who is able to vote;
4. Recommends that the UN send in peacekeepers to help the maintain the cease-fire and oversee the withdrawal of heavy weapons;
5. Calls upon peacekeepers to regulate the border between Crimea and Russia and enforce any ceasefires that are agreed upon;
6. Encourages the implementation of a demilitarized zone in Crimea enforced by United Nations peacekeepers as part of the ceasefire;
7. Endorses the placement of certain sanctions on the offender should the laws of the

demilitarized zone be ignored and the removal of certain sanctions should the laws be respected for specific amount of time;

8. Emphasizes that the people of Crimea vote upon the diplomatic state of Crimea remain in Ukrainian or become a Micro State;
9. Requests that UN peacekeepers monitor legal regional trade and goods transferred throughout the Black Sea; and
10. Declaring that the UN wants to help build the GRAF United Agency as fast as possible and build up the contact among sides and make the items practical and effective so that they support the resolution to the conflict.
