Stating that cars have already been made from eco-energy and we intend to make more,

- 1. Authorizes worldwide funding to create wildlife reserves;
- 2. Calls upon all nations to work to this problem;
- 3. Further requests putting a limit on killing non-sustainable animals;
- 4. Emphasizes the fact that we must help countries create better practices for commercial fishing;
- 5. Also recommends that we help animals in pain;
- 6. Creates a program where we can educate people about this issue;
- 7. Eradicates souvenirs made out of animals;
- 8. Suggests that the population begins to use and manufacture hybrid cars;
- 9. Reduces the amount of invasive alien species;
- 10. Establishes acts and laws to preserve the ecosystems (forests, biodiversity and more);
 - a. Recommends to increase protected areas for biodiversity;
- 11. Encourages to use alternative eco-friendly methods to power various devices;
- 12. Tells countries to sustain biodiversity by filtering factories water, and exhaust

before releasing it into the ocean and air;

- 13. Also suggests that all countries work with UN-REDD;
- 14. Requests more security and laws on poaching.
