Co-Sponsors: Federal Republic of Nigeria, Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, Republic of Rwanda, Peoples Republic of China, and Russian Federation

Topic: Situation in Ukraine

The Security Council, expressing their grave concern for the escalation in violence since the beginning of the conflict in Ukraine in November of 2013,

Reaffirming Resolution 2202 calling for a withdrawal of all weapons and artillery to an equal distance from both sides in order to create a safety zone, and regional elections to elect East Ukrainian officials,

Emphasizing the need to create a ceasefire between the Ukraine government and the separatists,

1. Requests a ceasefire between the Ukraine government and the separatist forces through these actions;
 - a. Appoint opposition leaders as government officials,
 - b. Hold regional elections to elect east Ukrainian officials,
 - c. Ensure the safety of the Russians in Ukraine;

2. Further recommends all official and unofficial troops to withdraw to their borders;
 - a. Suggests Russian unofficial troops withdraw to their borders,
 - b. Suggests Ukraine troops pull back to a safe distance outside the firing range; and

3. Requests Russia and Ukraine eases border control for both Crimea and Ukraine citizens who wish to cross the border and immigrate;
