## **Topic: Small Arms Trade**

The General Assembly,

Alarmed by the rate of small arms trade, expressing the need to eliminate illicit trafficking of small arms, emphasizing the need to be aware around small arms, confident that if all countries work together we can solve this problem, deeply concerned by the amount of violent video games and toys for kids, expressing appreciation for past actions,

- 1. Authorize a government exchange program that exchanges firearms for money and supplies;
- 2. Calls upon the installation of education programs for youth;
- 3. Draws the attention to the importance of regulating the amount of ammunition in circulation;
- 4. Emphasizes the importance of the controlled distribution of small arms;
- 5. Express its hopes for instituting an annual renewal process for registered firearms; and
- 6. Calls upon all countries to reduce small arms and ammunition stockpiles.
- 7. Further recommends keeping track of all items crossing the national border, such as ammunition and arms.
